

BOARD FOR BARBERS AND COSMETOLOGY APPLICATION REVIEW MATRIX CRIMINAL HISTORY

Effective May 7, 2018

The following convictions will not be reviewed by the Board*:

1. Felony convictions more than 20 years old with no subsequent reportable convictions of a similar nature, unless the conviction resulted in incarceration where the release date is less than three years from the application date.
2. Felony convictions more than five years old with no subsequent reportable convictions of a similar nature, unless the conviction resulted in incarceration where the release date is less than three years from the application date. This does not include convictions involving murder, sexual assault, rape, robbery, indecent liberties, fraud, embezzlement.
3. Felony convictions for possession of controlled substance more than two years old, where the applicant has completed a deterrence program if required by the court.
4. Felony convictions of Title 46 of the *Code of Virginia* (Traffic Code) more than two years old.
5. Misdemeanor convictions where the applicant has no record of felony convictions.
6. Misdemeanor convictions more than one year from the date of application.
7. Misdemeanor convictions for assault, disorderly conduct, drunk in public, petit larceny, failure to appear, and/or trespassing.
8. Misdemeanor convictions for possession or distribution of a controlled substance with no other convictions.
9. DUI convictions where the applicant has completed VASAP or another similar program accepted by the court or DMV after the latest conviction if required by the court. This does not include felony convictions.
10. Juvenile convictions.

*The matrix shall not apply to applicants who are currently incarcerated, except those incarcerated for juvenile convictions.
