### Guidance Document: Approved Health Education Certifying Agencies

The following health education (as referred to in 18 VAC 41-50, including limited term tattooers, and 18 VAC 41-60) is deemed acceptable to the Board. Documentation verifying course completion shall bear the name of the individual as it appears on the application or license as well as the name of the Board approved certifying agency.

#### **Content delivery requirements:**

Adult CPR – no more than ½ the content delivered online; ½ in person/classroom

First Aid – no more than ½ the content delivered online; ½ in person/classroom
